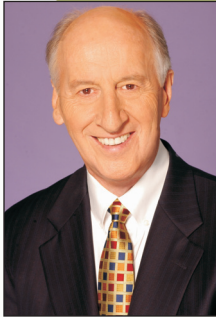

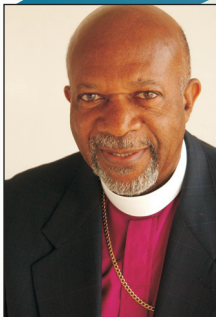

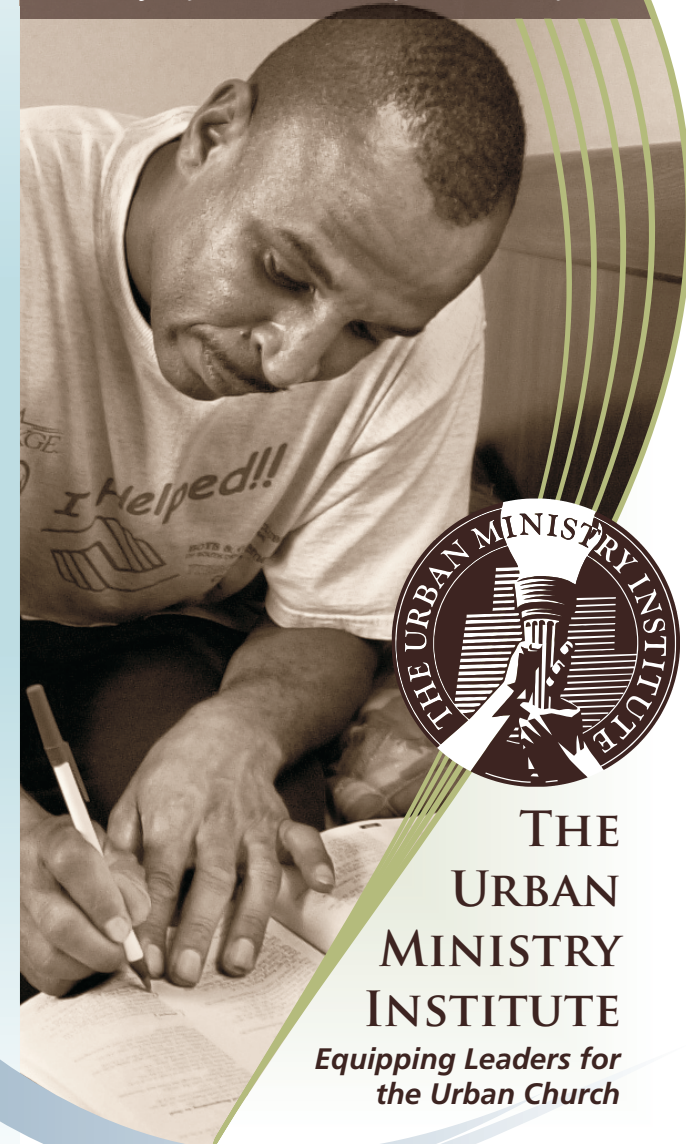

THE NEED

FOR MOST in urban ministry, attending seminary is virtually impossible because:

- It is too expensive.
- It is too far away.
- The academic requirements are too restrictive.
- The content is unrelated to inner-city life.

Inner-city pastors or lay leaders who want a theological education must change cultures and know someone who is rich.



THE ANSWER

IN 1995, World Impact established *The Urban Ministry Institute* (TUMI) to make affordable and relevant ministry education possible, right in the communities where urban leaders serve.

This seminary-level material, called the *Capstone Curriculum*, is comprised of 16 modules, covering everything needed to pastor an urban church. It is similar to what a Masters of Divinity student receives, minus the languages.

THE SATELLITE PROGRAM

IN 2000, World Impact began establishing satellite campuses in churches, urban ministries, prisons and Indian reservations, serving hundreds of students worldwide.

Satellites develop leaders in the local church, using TUMI's curriculum and guidelines.

The courses are based on the Nicene Creed, which predates denominations. Each site can add its own polity, making it consistent with a specific tradition.

After satisfactory completion of 16 modules, students receive a *Certificate of Leadership Studies* from *The Urban Ministry Institute*. Other flexible certificate programs can be designed, upon approval by the Institute.

Students typically finish their certificate in three to four years since they often work full-time jobs and serve as bi-vocational pastors.

THE INSTRUCTORS



DR. DON DAVIS, TUMI's Director and World Impact's Vice President of Leadership Development, graduated from Wheaton College and the University of Iowa.



ENRIQUE SANTIS, the Spanish Capstone translator and presenter, served for several years as World Impact's Director of Hispanic Ministries.

STARTING YOUR OWN TUMI SATELLITE

TO BEGIN a satellite, you must have:

- Christian leaders eager to receive biblical training
- A person committed to coordinating the program with a functional office and classroom
- A mentor/teacher to facilitate the leadership-development process (the coordinator can mentor the students, or a second volunteer can mentor)
- Agreement with World Impact's Statement of Faith.
- United States agent or partner, if located outside the United States.



WHAT WE PROVIDE

- READY-TO-USE curriculum including a mentor's guide and four hours of DVD teaching for each course
- Instructions on how to set up and maintain a satellite
- Discount fees for curriculum
- Certificate and diploma options
- Use of TUMI's name and logo
- Grant assistance for most of the start-up costs. On-going costs can be passed on to the student (about \$60/course), or scholarship funds can be raised at your site.
